They saw no issues for the lake and mentioned that the company had let their permit to draw water from Mississauga creek lapse. The quarry reservoirs themselves provided all they needed.
- No one is aware of the next steps planned for road work on Philrick Drive and nearby roads. Kim will write a letter requesting an update from council.
- Nancy mentioned membership was down this year and she asked for suggestions to be passed along.
